### LIEUTENANT A.W. LAMBERT GRADUATES FBI NATIONAL ACADEMY

*Quantico, Virginia* - Two hundred forty-six law enforcement officers graduated on June 10, 2011 from the FBI National Academy. The 245th Session of the National Academy consisted of men and women from 48 states. Included in the class were members of law enforcement agencies from the District of Columbia, 22 international countries, three military organizations, and two federal civilian organizations. Among the students was local officer Lieutenant Angel Lambert of the Caroline County Sheriff's Office. Lt. Lambert is the first Caroline County Sheriff's Office representative to ever attend the FBI National Academy.

Internationally known for its academic excellence, the National Academy Program, held at the FBI Academy, offers 10 weeks of advanced investigative, management, and fitness training for selected officers having proven records as professionals within their agencies. Lambert, who has a bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice from Virginia Commonwealth University, completed six college level courses over the ten week program as well as an advanced physical training program that prepared her for the completion of the U.S. Marine Corp 6.1 mile obstacle course affectionately known as "The Yellow Brick Road".
