FORT A.P. HILL TO HOST YOUTH DEER HUNT

FORT A.P. HILL, Va. – Area youth are invited to participate in Fort A.P. Hill’s Youth Deer Hunt being hosted by the installation’s Outdoor Recreation Services, Sept. 25.

The installation hunt will afford deer hunters, 15 and under, an opportunity to hunt with a shotgun, muzzleloader or bow. Youth hunters, however, must be accompanied and directly supervised by an adult who has a valid Virginia Hunting License and a 2010-2011 Fort A.P. Hill hunting permit.

To ensure the safety of all participants and per installation hunting regulations, both the youth and adult hunters must wear a blaze orange hat and vest. In addition, adults accompanying the youth hunter may not carry or discharge a firearm.

The hunt day will begin at 5:30 a.m. and will include a presentation by the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries at noon as well as a Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation food truck at the Outdoor Recreation parking lot for food sales.
