JOIN CAROLINE COUNTY AND VDOT FOR ROADSIDE CLEANUP ON MAY 29

County and agency leaders encourage community involvement to keep Virginia roadsides clean with pickup event in Carmel Church area

WHO: Caroline County Board of Supervisors; Caroline County staff; Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) Fredericksburg Residency staff; Adopt-a-Highway partners; and allied organizations.

WHAT: In support of spring cleanup efforts underway across the Fredericksburg region, participants from Caroline County, VDOT and partners will collect litter along several state-maintained roads in Caroline County's Carmel Church area.

WHEN: **Wednesday, May 29, 2019 at 9 a.m.**

WHERE: Roadside cleanup will occur along Carmel Church Loop and Rogers Clark Boulevard. Participants will meet in the parking lot of the Caroline County Visitors Center at [23724 Rogers Clark Boulevard](#).

After a brief welcome, participants will be divided into teams to collect litter at designated points along the selected routes for approximately 60 minutes.

WHY: Litter is illegal, unsightly and unsafe. Caroline County and VDOT are committed to keeping roadsides clean and hope to spur new and growing involvement in local communities.

MEDIA VISUALS: Participants can join in the cleanup effort, learn more about ongoing efforts and collect footage. Safety vests, hard hats, gloves and litter collection bags will be provided.

PARKING: Please park on Omaha Drive, which is the road leading to the Visitors Center parking lot. The event kickoff will begin in the parking lot.
