



3 Ways to Vote in the November 2, 2021 General Election

1. **Vote by Mail** – If you feel more comfortable voting at home, please go online at <https://vote.elections.virginia.gov/VoterInformation> and request that your ballot be mailed to your home. Once you receive your ballot please follow the instructions provided. Fill in the information on Envelope B. Place your ballot inside Envelope B. **Always** place your voted ballot inside the postage paid envelope. Mail the envelope.
2. **Early Voting** – Beginning September 17, 2021 you can vote in person at the Office of the General Registrar, 212 North Main Street, Bowling Green, VA 22427. This is in person voting. You must provide an ID to vote. No appointment is necessary. The office is open Monday-Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. The office is open Saturday, October 23rd and October 30th from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. for Early Voting.
3. **Vote on Election Day** – November 2, 2021. Vote in person as you always have on Election Day at your precinct. The list of precincts is listed here <https://co.caroline.va.us/DocumentCenter/View/1894/Caroline-County-Polling-Locations-With-Photos> The polls are open 6 a.m. to 7 p.m.
